News Flash: The latest news in the Sacramento Bee this morning (03.12.2010) had to deal with health care subsidies. It appears that the county lost a decision in the 3rd District Court of Appeals regarding charges brought on by several employee unions which stated the county couldn't unilaterally do away with retiree health care benefits for those who retired after May 31, 2007. This ruling, if left unchallenged, would require the county to pay back with interest benefits to those employees' and ultimately could affect the county to reinstate our former subsidy. It is unclear what the county will do next. The next option for the county quite possibly will be the state Supreme Court.
