

The following Ordinance was added to the Sacramento County Code on April 10th 2001. The 711 Club wants all retirees to be aware of their benefits in this Ordinance.

2 . 78 . 497 RETIREE COURT APPEARANCE FEES.

- (a) A retired County employee who is subpoenaed to appear in Court on behalf of the County in his or her capacity as a former County employee, shall receive a Court appearance fee if the employee reports at the time specified for his or her particular testimony regardless of whether the employee is ultimately required to testify. The Court appearance fee shall be one hundred twenty-five dollars (\$125.00) for a full day or seventy-five dollars (\$75.00) for a half day, which is defined as four (4) hours or less.
- (b) Amounts paid hereunder are inclusive of any fees, including mileage fees, otherwise required by law to be paid for a subpoenaed Court appearance.
- (c) This section shall not apply to a retired County employee who, at the time he or she is subpoenaed to appear in Court on behalf of the County, is under contract to provide services to the County or is employed as a retired annuitant.
- (d) Nothing herein shall serve to establish an employment relationship for any purpose, including, but not limited to, employee benefits, reimbursements, compensation, Court cancellation fee, or any other rights.
