One thing that came to light during the lead-up to range day was the issue of Retiree ID Cards. Some members discovered theirs had expired, and they would not have enough time to renew them in order to qualify. The range staff cannot sign off any qualification slip for any person who does not have a <u>valid and current</u> SSD ID card, with the CCW endorsement. We are finding out that the process can be lengthy, so don't wait until the last minute to renew. The application for renewal has to be filled out. Contact Live Scan ID 874-8076. They will fill out an application and deliver it to SSD Admin. for approval. It will then make it's rounds to everyone who has to sign off on it to establish you as a retiree in good standing. This might take several days, and once it is done you will be notified of your appointment date and time to come to the ID Live Scan station in the Headquarter's lobby. <u>You must have an appointment</u>. You will then be issued your ID Card. The CCW endorsement will be on it even if you have not qualified at the range. You will be authorized to carry concealed in California. The annual range qualification allows you to carry in all 50 states
