From the President

Greetings! This month, this President's message is from me the President. Thank you, Kathy Shannon, for a job well done chairing the October meeting in my absence. I announced that I had canceled our scheduled speaker due to a concern regarding a SCERS Tax Reporting Fiasco that has affected some of our club members and many SCERS retirees. I received an e-mail from Kathy Shannon that there was a problem regarding the Tax Period of 2015. Several SCERS retirees have received letters from the IRS stating that they owe money on their 2015 taxes. I asked our meeting attendees if any of them had received the mentioned letter. About 7 or 8 members acknowledged they had. In short, if you receive this letter, call Margaret Duggers at SCERS, 916-874-4981. She will give you information on how to proceed. Upon contacting SCERS they will send out a letter and a copy of the 1099-R to use when you respond to the IRS. SCERS is researching how this could have happened. One of our 711 Club members, retired Deputy Tim Kelly is a Tax Attorney. He brought this to Kathy's attention via E-mail. "It is not known if this is an error in reporting by SCERS or by the IRS" Tim is assisting about 30+ retirees get through this problem and has received many calls from others.

SCERS has a new CEO. He is Eric Stern. Stern currently leads the program on retirement and health benefits at the California Department of Finance as the Chief Executive Officer of the pension fund.
