Veterans Info – Jim Crump wanted us all to know that he was on a committee for veterans complaints. It meets quarterly. Contact him if you have any issues about your benefits.

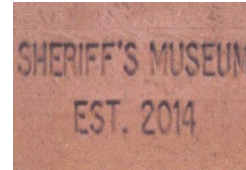
Meeting Adjourned at 1:26 p.m.
