Speaker: Kevin Mickelson, SCDSA President

The County is sending more detailed reports to SCERS on the hours that retirees are working. Five people worked over the 960 hours allowed for the year. Soft cushion to be in place of 920 with 960 still being the authorized hours for an annuitant to work in a year. In the future if you work over 960 hours you will be dismissed.

SCERS notified the Sheriff's Department that they believe there is a limit on how long annuitants can work. Language says 960 hours in a year. Discussion taking place that law enforcement will be exempt with everyone else being two years maximum.

Kurt Howard will be holding a social security type workshop in the next month.

When you are retired but working as an annuitant SCDSA picks up the cost of legal defense insurance if you have a CCW. If you are not working and have a CCW there is no legal defense coverage. You can join the Fraternal Order of Police and have the coverage for approximately \$50.00.
