You still must comply with any state laws when you travel and should make sure you understand any limitations such as magazine capacity.

May 22, 2019, Range Day and Lunch
This is for paid members of the 711 Club

This is a reminder that the annual range day will be held on May 22, 2019, at the Kenneth Royal Range. This is the **4th** Wednesday in May.

You are **not** required to qualify for in-state CCW authorization.

If you want to qualify for out of state carry (18USC 926c/ HR 218):

Bring your own weapon, and a holster. You must shoot from a holster. **You bring your own ammo** -The session is 20 rounds per qualification. **Your Retired ID must be current** to shoot. If it is expired you will not be able to shoot for qualification. Range staff will check for your SSD/Retired ID before they send you to the firing line, to ensure you are an eligible shooter.

The range fee has been waived by Sheriff Jones, for SSD members.

As usual, the range qualifications will start about 0800 and continue until about noon.

The Lunch will be catered by Mike Garcia and the Tai-Mex catering.

The lunch is \$15.00 and will include sodas and cold water. You don't have to purchase lunch but you need to RSVP for a head count for the range.
