### Speaker: Mindi Russell

Chaplain Mindi Russell spoke about the Sacramento Law Enforcement Chaplaincy and it's history. She started by saying "Thank You" to SSD for supporting the Chaplaincy when it first started and "letting us (the Chaplaincy) fly." It started in 1994 with 4 chaplains. They contacted the Coroner's Office and requested to do the death notices. The Chaplaincy now has it's own academy that includes 600 hours of training. The academy is POST certified. In 2020, there are now 150 chaplains with 25 in training. By the end of the year, there will be 225 chaplains. The Chaplaincy works hard on the wellness of the officer. It also works to help the officer keep his/her values and beliefs intact. There are events that benefit the Chaplaincy: Run with Cops, Ride With Fallen Officers.


