**Range Day May 20th****If you want to qualify for out of state carry (18USC 926c/ HR 218):**

**Bring your own weapon, and a holster. You must shoot from a holster. You must bring your own ammo** -The session is 20 rounds per qualification. **Your Retired ID should be current** to shoot. If it is expired you may not be able to shoot for qualification. Range staff could check for your SSD/Retired ID before they send you to the firing line, to ensure you are an eligible shooter.

The range fee has been waived by Sheriff Jones, for SSD members.

As usual, the range qualifications will start about 0800 and continue until about noon.

The Lunch will be catered by Mike Garcia and the Tai-Mex catering.

The lunch is \$20.00 and will include sodas and cold water. You don't have to purchase lunch but you need to RSVP for a head count for the range.

## **Speaker: Mindi Russell**

Chaplain Mindi Russell spoke about the Sacramento Law Enforcement Chaplaincy and its history. She started by saying "Thank You" to SSD for supporting the Chaplaincy when it first started and "letting us (the Chaplaincy) fly." It started in 1994 with 4 chaplains. They contacted the Coroner's Office and requested to do the death notices. The Chaplaincy now has its own academy that includes 600 hours of training. The academy is POST certified. In 2020, there are now 150 chaplains with 25 in training. By the end of the year, there will be 225 chaplains. The Chaplaincy works hard on the wellness of the officer. It also works to help the officer keep his/her values and beliefs intact. There are events that benefit the Chaplaincy: Run with Cops, Ride With Fallen Officers.

NCPOA's March meeting has been cancelled.


Meeting adjourned at 1:00 p.m.
