By Law Revision

To all 711 Club members:

Problem:

The following is a copy of the amended By Laws for the 711 Club approved by the Officers and Board. It will go into effect April 14, 2021. The change is to address the number of members necessary for a quorum at meetings to approve business. The old By Law 5, paragraph 5 requires a quorum of 10% which is approximately 50 members. Our meetings rarely draw 50 members at one time and that hinders business being conducted that needs member approval. This change would allow business to be approved by a majority vote of the members present at the meeting. It would also allow members not in attendance to use a proxy to vote.

Current: 711 Club By Laws as amended November 14, 2018. By Law 5, paragraph 5 reads:

5. **A quorum of regular members will consist of at least ten (10) percent of the regular members in good standing. All business of the membership will be conducted by majority vote, by show of hands, at any meeting at which a quorum is in attendance. A lack of a quorum at the time of the vote will defeat the vote. If any vote results in a tie, a secret ballot may be conducted.**

Solution:

Rewrite: of By Law 5, paragraph 5 (draft) as of Feb 10, 2021:

A quorum of regular members will consist of a **majority** of regular members in attendance at any regular or special meeting. All business of the membership will be conducted by majority vote, by voice or show of hands, at any meeting at which a vote is taken. If any vote results in a tie, a secret ballot may be conducted. **Proxies** may be given in writing to any Officer or Board of Director member attending the meeting, to be used in the member's absence.

I hope you as a member agree with the necessary change. No response is necessary if you agree. If you don't agree please notify a board member to voice your opinion.
