WE NEED YOUR PROXY (VOTE) FOR A BY LAW CHANGE

By-Law Change – At the Board of Directors Meeting on February 10, 2021 your board voted to make changes to By-Law V, paragraph 5. The changes were sent out by email February 2021, mailed to members without email addresses and discussed in the Newsletter.

This by-law has been re-written to need only a quorum of regular members present to vote by voice or show of hands at any meeting where a vote is taken. Proxies (votes) may be given in writing to any Officer or Board Director attending the meeting, to be used in the member's absence. This by-law will be voted on at the April 14, 2021, General Meeting.

We are still bound by the old quorum rule of 10% of the total membership (approx. 50 members) needing to be present to conduct business. Therefore, we need members not attending the April 14th meeting to forward there proxy via email to a board member to vote on the new By Law revision. The meetings, due to Covid, are only drawing approx. 25 members. Therefore, a quorum is not usually present to be able to conduct business requiring a vote. Thus this change is being made to By Law V. Please get your proxy in before April 14th. Include the following information in your email: Remember you have to be a dues paying member to vote.
