Sunshine Report: Lee Harms has cancer. Del Foster was in the hospital but is back home now.

Speaker: Mindy Russell – Law Enforcement Chaplaincy (LEC) – Mindy explained to the group what a constitutional chaplain is. They must meet three criteria; 1) no government involvement, 2) must be religion neutral and 3) must have a secular purpose. The LEC offers different courses for officers. During the pandemic, the LEC were contacts in the field and in the hospital. The LEC was approached by the State of California to see if they would start a statewide program. Due to resources the LEC could not take that big of project on. They have started a second group called the California Chaplains Corp and will be working with chaplains from all over the state. Mindy was presented a check from the 711Club for the LEC in the amount of \$1,000.
