## President's Message continued:

Hello everyone. I was unable to attend our October 2021 general membership meeting. Thank you VP Sue Johnson for filling in for me, and authoring the October message pertinent to the meeting. In addition to Sue's message, I'd like to talk about a few items.

Grant Wilson was a District Attorney Criminal Investigator who was killed in the line of duty by gunfire in August, 1981, while serving a warrant. Grant was a Sacramento County Deputy Sheriff for six years prior to that. Kathy Shannon sent out a message yesterday containing much more detail about that tragic event and Grant's death. Grant's partner, Investigator Kamber was also shot during this incident and severely injured, fortunately surviving.

Rich Allen is a current Supervising Criminal Investigator with the Sacramento District Attorney's Office. Both Sue Johnson and I had the pleasure of working with Rich while we were Criminal Investigators with that office. Rich is working on a memorial plaque for Grant, and that effort is addressed in greater detail in Kathy Shannon's message. Please read it if you haven't already. Please, let's not forget our comrade who was killed during this incident, and Investigator Kamber.
