Speaker: Steve Ahee – Officerprivacy.com started by retired Lieutenant Pete James
Steve talked about how law enforcement seems to be under attack these days. Personal information is available on-line for officers and their families. Officers are being followed home and homes are being vandalized or more.

You may want to check your internet security and delete your information. The top five websites to check are: whitepages.com, spokeo.com, beenverified.com, mylife.com, instantcheckmate.com. When deleting your information, you need to use a “fresh” email account. You will also need a phone number for each account such as (916) 555-1234 or (916) 555-0092. Once you delete your information from all the sites you still need to check back, and you may have to do it all again.

Officerprivacy.com offers two options. Option 1 - If you want to do it yourself, you can download officerprivacy.com software free for 14 days. Software is user friendly and gives you step by step directions. If you want to continue to do it yourself, you can pay \$10.00 a month for continued use of the software.

Option 2 is to have officerprivacy.com do everything for you. One-time cost of \$199 to remove you from 50 sites and a monthly fee of \$20.00 for monitoring/removal. You receive progress reports, updates. You can go on-line to fill out the application. You are free to cancel anytime, and you can get your money back.
