Re: Retiree CCW Qualifications

Dear John,

The Sacramento Sheriff's Department has revised General Order 13/05 (Issuance of Retirement ID Credential and Retiree Concealed Weapon Authorizations). The Order now states the Range Staff will now only qualify retirees who meet the standards under the Law Enforcement Safety Act, commonly called HR 218. Each eligible retiree shall be required to show their department identification. Individuals shall be required to bring their own factory ammunition (20-25 rounds for each firearm). We are not collecting a range qualification fee at this time.

Honorably Retired Peace Officers and Level 1 Reserve Peace Officers are not required annual firearms qualifications to comply with the State of California CCW privileges.

Retired Level II and III Reserve Peace Officers desiring to possess or maintain a CCW permit must comply with all existing public Sacramento County CCW firearms qualifications. They will be required to qualify at an outside location to maintain their CCW status.

The Range Staff will make qualifications available in January, February, July, and August. Qualifications will be the same day as normal department qualifications. For the safety of the officers and Range Staff, all courses of fire shall be shot from a holster that is compatible with the gun. Absolutely no exceptions will be made.
