Speaker: Mike Ziegler, Undersheriff. The Sheriff and Mike worked together in several work assignments before Cooper got elected to State Office. Mike was asked by Cooper to serve as his political officer and served with him 8 years at the Capital. All politics are local and serving is encouraged. The Sheriff and Undersheriff are using relationships built up to get bad bills changed to not so horrible for law enforcement.

Patrol has 18 shifts and they have visited all of them. They have enacted a Training Development Group that picks up after Patrol Training is completed.
