Scott was Danny Oliver's partner (working POP Team on October 24, 2014) and walked everyone through events that happened on that day and in the years that followed,

When coping with a traumatic event who should you talk to: co-workers; agency psychologist; clergy/member of your church; family members. Family members need to understand what you are going through.

There are companies that offer assistance/retreats: WCPR, SOS, COPS, PCIS & others.

Took 3  $\frac{1}{2}$  years to get to trial. Suspect received 2 death penalties, 3 life sentences plus 300 years. His wife received 70-80 years but may be out in five years due to a change in the Felony Murder Rule.

A little brief paragraph to introduce you to Kris Pedretti:

Kris Pedretti grew up in a suburb of Sacramento in the 1970s. At the time residents considered it a safe community where they didn't have to lock their doors and left windows open at night.

That feeling was shattered in 1976 when the east area rapist, also known as the Golden State Killer, began his reign of tear in the community. Kris was barely 15 years old on December 18, 1976 when she became victim number 10 and was raped multiple times by the GSK.

Fast forward to today. Kris is the driving force to updating and renovating soft interview rooms for the central station in Rancho Cordova.
